**About Steve Smiley:** Steve just completed his 2<sup>nd</sup> season as head coach at national junior college powerhouse Sheridan College. In the past 2 seasons, the Generals overall record is 53-14, winning two North Sub-Region 9 titles, one Wyoming Conference Title, advancing twice to the Region 9 Final 4 and appearing in one championship game. Steve was named North Sub-Region 9 Coach of the Year this past season. Prior to Sheridan, Steve spent two seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Northern State University (Aberdeen, SD) under the winningest coach in NCAA History, Don Meyer. During his time, the Wolves went 50-12. Prior to his return at NSU, Steve was the head assistant coach at Black Hills State University. During his first year, the Yellow Jackets finished in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Dakota Athletic Conference and lost in the conference championship by one point. Steve finished his senior season at Northern State University (Aberdeen, SD) in the spring of 2004. Steve was a starter since his sophomore season. During his career, Steve led the Northern Sun league in assists for three consecutive seasons. Steve finished second all-time at NSU in career assists with 537, and was only the second player in school history to surpass the 500-assist mark. Steve was the starting point guard for NSU teams that won the conference title during his sophomore and junior seasons. As a senior, Steve won the NSIC Defensive Player of the Year award, and the Wolves posted a final record of 24-7, won the conference tournament for the first time, and played in the NCAA D2 national tournament. Steve was named to the All-Tournament Team, and was also named as the NSIC Tournament MVP.

**About Houston Reed:** Houston Reed just finished his fourth year as the Otero Junior College head men's basketball coach. Coach Reed returns to Otero after graduating from Otero in 2000. While playing at Otero, the Rattlers won two Region IX sub-region titles, and Reed earned all-region honors as a sophomore. Coach Reed also holds the record for most points scored in a single game in school history with 46 points vs New Mexico Junior College, and currently sits 11th on the all-time scoring leader board. Following Otero, Coach Reed played for two seasons at Northern State University in Aberdeen, South Dakota under legendary coach Don Meyer. While at Northern, Reed was part of a conference championship and twice was recognized with a NSU scholar-athlete award. He also worked several coaching clinics under Don Meyer that featured Dick Bennett, Pat Summit, and John Wooden. Following his college experience, Reed coached at Las Animas High School and was the head basketball coach at Rocky Ford High School for the 3 seasons. While at Las Animas High School the team went 20-3 and made a regional appearance.

**About Dan Magrino:** Dan Magrino just finished his first season as the head assistant coach to Don Meyer at Northern State University. Before coming back to NSU, Dan was an assistant coach at Division 2 Georgia College. He helped lead GCSU to a 22-7 record and a 15-5 record in the highly touted Peach Belt Conference. Georgia College was also ranked as high as 14<sup>th</sup> in the nation with Magrino on staff as well. Magrino worked exclusively with the Bobcat post players, his area of expertise as a player. Before Georgia College, Dan was at Northern State (S.D.) University where he played from 2003-2008. As a Wolf, Dan had a career shooting percentage of 63% and helped lead them to a 98-28 record during his playing career. Magrino double majored in sociology and political science. Originally from Pembroke Pines, Fla., Magrino played at Pembroke Pines Charter High School.
